### 1.0 Local Travel

Green Truck Moving \& Storage uses a GPS based travel charge to ensure the accuracy of our customers local travel time. This eliminates our customers from having to pay for costing factors such as Traffic, Weather, and Break times. The GPS based travel is based on the hourly move rate for the move. If a customer has an hourly move rate of $\$ 99 / \mathrm{hr}$. then the travel rate will be $\$ 99.00$ prorated to the correct increment of time traveled. For example, if the customer has a total travel time of 30 minutes then the cost for travel is $\$ 49.50$. A Green Truck local move travel time is defined as the time it takes to travel from our headquarters at 3330 Ambrose Ave. Nashville, TN 37208 to the customers origin address, added to the time it takes to travel from the customer's new address back to our headquarters.

### 1.1 Long Distance Travel Rates

Green Truck Moving \& Storage interstate moves consist of a fuel charge and travel time rate. The fuel charge is calculated at a cost of $\$ 0.68 /$ mile. The cost of mileage starts from our headquarters to the pickup origin, continuing to the destination, then back to our office. The travel time rate is always the same as the labor rate. If the interstate labor rate is $\$ 155 / \mathrm{hr}$. for 2 men and 1 truck then the travel time will be $\$ 155 / \mathrm{hr}$. The travel time is the GPS based calculation of the time it takes to drive from the customer's origin to the destination, then back to our headquarters. The travel time rate is based on roundtrip travel as well.

### 1.2 Local Move Cost Rates

The Green Truck Moving \& Storage Co. uses an hourly rate to calculate the cost of each customers local moving needs based on the weight and or cubic feet of their listed inventory. This rate is based on the amount of Laborers and Trucks a customer needs for their relocation to be completed efficiently. These rates also include a travel time and fuel charge. The travel time rates can be found under Local Travel section 1.0 above. The local fuel charge for all customers is $10 \%$ of the total bill which includes labor plus travel. The chart(s) below is an explanation of hourly rates and fuel charge.

### 1.5 Storage Service Rates

Green Truck Storage uses Industry standard vaults to efficiently store our customer's items. These vaults are $7 \times 8 \times 7$ in dimension. Each vault holds an estimated 1000 lbs . Our company storage rates are determined by a per vault basis and are charged to our customers each month. Please see chart below to view a complete list of our storage rates.

### 1.9 Valuation Cost Rate

We encourage our customer to look over their valuation cost options found on their move confirmation email. As a company we train our movers to do everything they can to protect your household goods. Unfortunately incidents can sometimes still occur due to the nature of moving. It is important to understand your valuation options and choose the coverage that you are most comfortable with. Please understand that if damages to any of your household goods occur our insurance policy will only honor the coverage selected by you prior to your move. As a company we are federally mandated to offer at least 60 cents per pound valuation to all customers. We provide this coverage free of charge as a convenience to you. However, we also have other options for higher coverage that do have a cost associated with them. Please feel free to ask as many questions as possible in order to understand the valuation process and all options provided to you. The cost of your valuation options is based on the details \& inventory of your individual move. These cost can be found in your move confirmation email as well. Please see a breakdown of our valuation policy below.

## TGTMC Valuation Protection Options for Customers

## Option 1: Declared Value

As a company we are legally mandated to cover any damaged items caused by our company at .60/lb. per article. This option is free of charge to you as a customer and will be automatically assigned to you in the case that you do not select another option upon your move confirmation call.

For Example:
Move Type: Same coverage applies to all move types
Total Cash Value: Customer accepts standard coverage
Situational Analysis: A dresser weighing 100lbs is damaged. Our company will be responsible for
a.) Paying customer settlement of $.60 / \mathrm{lb}$. which totals to $\$ 60.00$.

## Option 2: Actual Cash Value

This choice gives you the option to receive up to $\$ 2.50 / \mathrm{lb}$. for damages. Upon company discretion we have the option to
a.) Pay up to $\$ 2.50 / \mathrm{lb}$. per damaged article
b.) Repair the damaged item and or
c.) Replace item damaged at current market value.

For Example:
Move type: 3 bedroom home
Total Cash Valuation: $\$ 10,000$ (Total valuation of goods is given based on size of home and inventory provided to Green Truck Representative during move set up process. The overall value of goods is determined by the size of your move and amount of inventory.)

Cost of Valuation Coverage: \$50.00
Deductible: \$200.00
Situation Analysis: A dresser weighing 100lbs is damaged. At $\$ 2.50 / \mathrm{lb}$. The Green Truck would be responsible for either once a deductible of $\$ 200.00$ is paid. (Based on company discretion)
a.) Paying $\$ 250.00$ to you as a customer
b.) Repairing the item to similar condition
c.) Replacing the item at current value

## Option 3: Full Replacement Value

This choice gives you the option to receive up to $\$ 5.00 / \mathrm{lb}$. Upon company discretion, we will be responsible for one of the options below
a.) pay up to $\$ 5.00 / \mathrm{lb}$. per damaged article
b.) repair damaged item and or
c.) replace damaged item at current market value. Under this option there is no deductible required.

For Example:

Total Cash Valuation: \$10,000 (Total valuation of goods is given based on size of home and inventory provided to Green Truck Representative during move set up process. The overall value of goods is determined by the size of your move and amount of inventory.)

Cost of Valuation Coverage: \$150
Situation Analysis: A dresser weighing 100lbs is damaged. At $\$ 5.00 / \mathrm{lb}$. The Green Truck would be responsible for one of the following options based on our discretion
a.) Paying $\$ 500$ to you as a customer
b.) Repairing the item to similar condition
c.) Replacing the item at its current market value
